- 1) Investigations in to obtaining current electoral roll and/or associated distribution services have proved fruitless.
 - a. Electoral Services – Legally cannot give us electoral roll and no longer offer additional services.
 - b. Herefordshire CC – NDP Team- no longer offer/no resource
 - c. Herefordshire CC - Research & Intelligence unit – no longer offer

However, Liz Parry Jones(PC Clerk) has discovered HALC offer, in conjunction with Hoople, to produce a label run for every household in the parish – please note Household – NOT resident. Cost is £30 set up + £1.50 per sheet. ACTION: MH. DUE: Next mtg

- 2) Core Strategy rural housing policy RA1. Clarification that the proportionate housing development required of Kings Cople over the next 18 years is 14% of nucleated village housing stock of 84 (not Parish stock) which equates to 11.76 (12) dwellings. One application (Seven Acres) is still active reducing this requirement to 11. This is the starting point for our NDP and should be taken as indicative. The RA1 scoring system is badly flawed and largely based on out of date data but it is what it is and with the present lack of resource at HCC we should not expect to get it updated any time soon. The AONB status that we enjoy does offer protection and opportunity to develop the village as we feel appropriate while at the same time conforming to the main thrust of the Core Strategy.
